(Romans 8)

INTRODUCTION

Three Salient Themes

I. THE SUPERIORITY OF THE SPIRIT (Romans 8:1-27)

(verse 26) The Spirit helps us in our weakness
*The key to the Christian life = The Holy Spirit!
.....We serve in the new way of the Spirit (Romans 7:6)

II. THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD (Romans 8:28-30)

(verse 28) In all things, God works together for good......

*Predestined to be like God's Son!

*God knows ahead of time and plans accordingly! (Ephesians 1:11-14, Philippians 1:6; 2:13)

III. "THE SECURITY OF THE BELIEVER (Romans 8:31-38)

(verse 31) If God is for us, who can be against us?

Four Questions

Who can be against us? Who can criticize God's people?

Who condemns? Who can separate us from Christ's love?

A: There is <u>no one</u>, nor <u>nothing</u> that can pull us from God! (verse 37).....We are more than conquerors through Christ!
