## Friday, August 26: Read Judges 16

Chapter 16 tells the sad tale of Samson's demise and his eventual death. What lessons can we glean from Samson's life that apply to us today? God answers Samson's dying prayer and uses his death to pry Israel free from the power of the Philistines. His name eventually surfaces in the New Testament as one of the four Judges of Israel considered to be men of faith. In spite of some glaring flaws, he is used by God twenty years as a Judge of Israel.

- Ask God to show you any specific action you need to take as you read.

# Weekly Readings

## Monday, August 22: Read Psalm 73

The author of this Psalm asks the classic "Why" question: Why do the evil succeed and the good struggle? Note carefully the progression of thought in this Psalm and the Psalmist's final conclusions. Can you make <u>verse 28</u> your own resolution today?

- 1. My relationship with God.
- 2. My life roles
- 3. My personal needs/weak areas
- 4. Goals and objectives

## Tuesday, August 23: Read *Ecclesiastes 4, 8 and 12*

Having looked at crooked judges this past Sunday, King Solomon struggles (as a good king) with injustice and inequities of life and the struggle to discover meaning. What is his final conclusion In <u>Chapter 12</u>? How can this help you when you wrestle with doubt?

## Wednesday August 24: Read Judges 13

We now turn to the next Judge of Israel -- Samson. Notice the supernatural intervention related to Samson's birth. What exactly is a Nazarite according to *Numbers 6*?

#### (Consider fasting one, two, or all meals this day.)



Remember God's warning to Israel in <u>Deuteronomy</u> 7:3-4. In a similar way we are told not to take unbelieving spouses in <u>2 Corinthians 6:14</u>.
