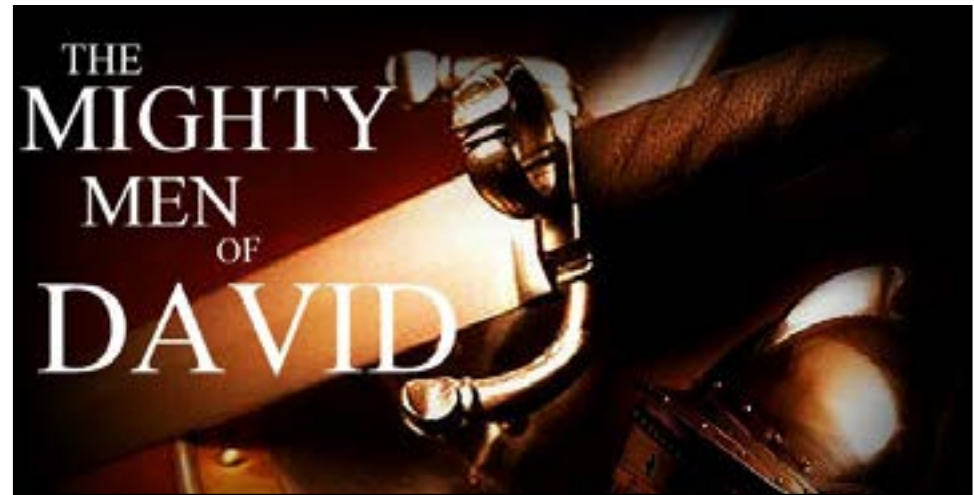

Spiritual Disciplines

Reading Assignments

- Invite the Holy Spirit to guide your reading each day.
- Read the chapters of the Bible according to the date.
- Underline any meaningful verses and take note of specific advice or wisdom gleaned from your reading.
- Note any unclear passages or teaching and seek insight, answers or help.
- Think about what you're reading. Ask:
 1. How does this apply to me?
 2. Are there any temptations to avoid, sins to confess, commands to obey or promises to claim?
 3. What insight do I gain on God, myself, others, or life?
- Ask God to show you any specific action you need to take as you read.

Weekly Readings

Monday, November 28: Read [1 Chronicles 11-12](#), [2 Samuel 23](#).

Don't fret over lists of names in scripture. The in-depth detail adds authenticity to the text. Notice the descriptions of the kinds of men that followed David. Like attracts like. Great men with great causes draw great followers!

Monday Pray for:

1. *My relationship with God.*

Tuesday, November 29: Read [*Psalm 34*](#).

This Psalm is typical of David when facing enemies. Notice his staunch trust in God when things look bad, and then how quick he is to give God glory when deliverance comes. Take stock in verses 17-22; they are written for you too.

Pray for family and friends by name.

Wednesday November 30: Read [*Psalm 37*](#).

David was a man with a heart for God. This is often reflected in his Psalms as he extols God's goodness and glory. Notice the ongoing contrast between the righteous and the wicked. Take to heart the promises for the righteous as they are portrayed in this Psalm.

Thursday, December 1: Read [*Psalm 38*](#)

This Psalm is another of David's confession psalms, perhaps after he numbers the troops and God responds with a plague ([*2 Samuel 24:10-25*](#)). Do you have any thoughts, attitudes or actions to confess to God today as sin? If so, follow David's pattern of confession found in Psalm 38. God is ready to cleanse and forgive all who come to him repentant, humble and hopeful in his mercy.
