Friday, December 16: Read <u>Proverbs 19-20</u>

<u>Social courtesy</u> is another virtue that flows from wisdom. How you see and treat others reflects how you see and relate to God. Notice some of the counterparts to this trait as taught in the New Testament: <u>Matt. 7:12, Romans 12:18, Ephesians 4:32, Col. 4:6.</u> <u>Proverbs 14:31</u> is a great example of this virtue.



- Ask God to show you any specific action you need to take as you read.

Weekly Readings

Monday, December 12: Read Proverbs 11-12

This week we will center in on the Proverbs of King Solomon, specifically the characteristics of a wise person as Solomon describes them in his book. The first characteristic of a wise person as described by Solomon is *humility*. Note all references to pride and its counterpart humility, along with the fruits of each. How is humility cultivated? How does God respond to a humble heart according to *James 4:6, 10*?

Wednesday December 14: Read <u>Proverbs 15-16</u>

A third characteristic of wisdom is <u>honesty</u>. Note the numerous references to <u>the tongue</u> in these two chapters. According to Jesus, what do our words indicate? (<u>Mark 7:14-23</u>) What is Paul's admonition on speaking to others and how can you grow in this area? (<u>Ephesians 4:29-32</u>)
