(Bitterness, lust, worry, pride, doubt, addictions, greed, idolatry.....)

2. Yield control to the Holy Spirit

Submit yourselves to God.....([James 4:7](#))

Offer your body to God as a living sacrifice ([Romans 12:1](#))

3. Keep in step with the Spirit ([Galatians 5:25](#))

The mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace. ([Romans 8:6](#))
