- 1. Empty yourself of any known sin in your life (Galatians 5:17, 1 Corinthians 3;1-3; James 4:10) *Repentance = confess + renounce (Ephesians 5:11; 1 John 1:9) (Bitterness, lust, worry, pride, doubt, addictions, greed, idolatry.....) 2. Yield control to the Holy Spirit Submit yourselves to God.....(James 4:7) Offer your body to God as a living sacrifice (Romans 12:1)
- 3. Keep in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:25) The mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace. (Romans 8:6) *Spiritual Breathing (Bill Bright)
- But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses...(Acts 1:8)
