*Jesus: The Prototype (John 5:25; 6:38-39; 11:25-26)
"I am the Living One. I was dead, and behold I am alive forevermore! And I hold the keys of death and Hades." (<u>Revelation 1:18</u>)

III. The Final Destination: Heaven or Hell? (Hebrews 9:27)

*Heaven = The manifest presence of God *Hell = The abject absence of God *Can I know my eternal destiny? (<u>I John 5:11-13</u>)

IV. <u>The Question of Timing</u>
 *Our time space reality vs. The spiritual realm
 *Jesus and the thief on the cross
today you will be with me in paradise (<u>Luke 23:43</u>)
