Parables: The Secrets of the Kingdom (Mark 4:11,34)

I. THE KINGDOM IS SEED-LIKE

It has <u>power</u> within. <u>(Mark 4:26-29)</u>
It has great <u>potential</u> <u>(Mark 4:30-32)</u>
It's a selective <u>process</u> of growth <u>(Mark 4:3-8)</u>

- II. THE KINGDOM WILL BE REVEALED (*Mark 4:21-25*) ....whatever is hidden will be disclosed (*Mark 4:22*)

## 4 soils = 4 kinds of hearts

Path = hard-hearted
Rocks = shallow-hearted
Weeds = overcrowded hearts
Good soil = a receptive heart

The point = to grow to maturity and produce fruit!
