Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer.

- I. Take a few minutes to review this past week's <u>40 Days of Prayer Guide</u>. What day/verse was especially meaningful to you? Has prayer come easy or difficult this past week? How is God prompting you in your life circumstances through prayer?
- II. Pick up our study by reading <u>Mark 11:1-11</u>. What stands out to you in this story? Note the prophecy for this moment in <u>Zechariah 9:9</u>. What does Hosanna mean, and why do they call Jesus the son of David? (see <u>Psalm 118:26, Isaiah 56:7</u>). What do you suppose Israel was expecting Jesus to do next?
- III. Now read <u>Mark 11:15-19</u>. Did this fit with their hopes of Jesus' gaining power in Israel? Is there any tendency for Christians today to change the focus in "God's house" from prayer to profit? Explain your answers.
- IV. Finally, read <u>Mark 11:27-33</u>. Jesus' clash with the religious leaders is producing plenty of sparks. What "authority" (authorization, credentials) were the religious leaders looking for in Jesus? Why didn't he answer their question directly? What was ultimately at issue between Jesus and the Jewish leadership? (Note <u>John 5:16-24</u>)
