## **Small Group Discussion Guide**

Mark 13

Week of May 20, 2018

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to enlighten your study so you better understand the times that we are living in

- I. Last week we ended with <u>Mark 13:14-17.</u> Summarize what the Abomination of Desolation is, where it will occur and who it refers to.
- II. Let's look more closely at what's revealed about the Anti Christ. Read *Revelation 13:1-4*. Who is the Dragon and who is the Beast? What might the numbers 10 and 7 reveal? Any thoughts on the leopard, the bear and the lion? What about the fatal wound that was healed?
- III. Now read <u>Revelation 13:5-10</u>. What else do we learn about the Anti Christ in this passage? Who are the Saints and how will they fare during this time? Will Christians will be raptured before this? (<u>Matthew 24:31, 40-41, 1 Thess. 4:16-17</u>) What do you think?
- IV. Read further in <u>Revelation 13:11-18</u>. Who might this Second Beast be and what does he do? What is the mark (666) for and who will receive it? Any insights into the Mark of the Beast? Note how all who receive this mark will fare according to <u>Revelation 14:9-12</u>.
- V. Now go to 2 Thessalonians. Read again 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4. Notice the similarity to Revelation 13. Finally, read 2 Thessalonians 2:5-12. Explain how Satan will deceive people in the last days. According to this chapter, why will they perish? Is this true for most nonbelievers today? What is the "powerful delusion" and the lie "that the world will follow after"? Have we see this yet?

Finish by reading <u>Mark 13:32-37</u>. Ask God to heighten your awareness to the signs of the times. Let's be on guard and keep watch. Jesus will return again sometime in the future!
