### Introduction

## Bible 101

### I. Isaiah -- Introduction

Written by the prophet Isaiah over a span of some sixty years (740 - 680 B.C.) exhorting the nations to turn from evil to the Lord their Savior.

### II. Key Themes

Exhortations to Judah, and to the nations, Hezekiah, the holiness of God, salvation, the Messiah and his coming kingdom.

### III. Salvation: Three focuses of our study

1. The Exhortations of God.
2. The Promises of God.
3. The Character of God.

### IV. Prophecies to Judah ([Isaiah 1-12](#))

(examples from chapter one)

1. Exhortations (verses 2,4,17)
2. Promises (verses 18-19, 25-27)
3. God's Character
  - God is holy (verse 4)
  - God is mighty (verse 24)
