Isaiah: The Lord is Salvation

Introduction

Bible 101

I. Isaiah -- Introduction

Written by the prophet Isaiah over a span of some sixty years (740 - 680 B.C.) exhorting the nations to turn from evil to the Lord their Savior.

II. Key Themes

Exhortations to Judah, and to the nations, Hezekiah, the holiness of God, salvation, the Messiah and his coming kingdom.

III. Salvation: Three focuses of our study

- 1. The Exhortations of God.
 - 2. The Promises of God.
 - 3. The Character of God.

IV. Prophecies to Judah (Isaiah 1-12)

(examples from chapter one)

- 1. Exhortations (verses 2,4,17)
- 2. Promises (verses 18-19, 25-27)
- 3. God's Character

God is holy (verse 4)

God is mighty (verse 24)
