# Isaiah: The Lord is Salvation

Introduction

Mysteries of the Universe

Isaiah 58: Unanswered Prayer

You cannot fast as you to do today and expect your voice to be heard on high (Isaiah 58:4)

Judah: Going through the "religious motions"
\*(verse 5) Fasting ="moving faster towards God"
\*(verse 13) Sabbath Rests = ceasing labor to refocus

\*Note (*Exodus 20:8-11; 31:12-17*)

### II. Actions Speak Louder Than Words

\*Acts of mercy vs. religious piety.

\*Note (*Isaiah 58:6-7, 9-10*), (*Matthew 25:31-40*)

III. Israel in Jesus' Day (Mark 7:18)

\*Lip service vs. Life service

.....I desire mercy not sacrifice (Matthew 9:13)

Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom, because judgement without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgement! (James 2:12-13)
