 - * Result: Impact!
- II. The Promise of the Spirit
 - * In the last days I will pour out my Spirit....(Joel 2:28)
 - * I will send my Spirit (John 14, 16)
 - *Like "Living Water" (*John 4:10, 14; 7:37-39*)
 - * Like the power of the wind (John 3:8)
 - * Do not: Blaspheme, grieve, quench or test the Spirit!
 - *<u>Do</u>: Be born, walk, pray, keep in step, bear fruit, be guided and be gifted by the Spirit!
- III. The Key to the Christian Life (The Gift of the Holy Spirit)

How?

1. Empty yourself of any known sin in your life

(Galatians 5:17, 1 Corinthians 3;1-3; James 4:10)

*Repentance = confess + renounce (Ephesians 5:11; 1 John 1:9)
(Bitterness, lust, worry, pride, doubt, addictions, greed, idolatry.....)

2. Yield control to the Holy Spirit

Submit yourselves to God....(James 4:7)

Offer your body to God as a living sacrifice (Romans 12:1)

3. Keep in step with the Spirit (Galatians 5:25)

The mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace. (Romans 8:6)
