Calculate Risks

- I. Living is Risky Business
 - Definition: A risk = exposure to danger, difficulties or potential loss. **Risks are Instructive**
 - 1. Risks reveal values (*Matthew 4:19*)
 - 2. Risks require faith (Hebrews 11:1,6)
 - Risks represent rewards (Matthew 6:33, James 1:3)
