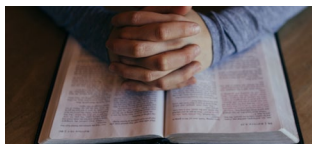

### II. Passing the “Test of Trust” (with straight A’s!)

#### 1. Assess your current life circumstances

*The wisdom of the prudent is to give thought to their ways....*(Prov. 14:8)

Key = Life roles/responsibilities

#### 2. Affirm all that is good.

*Every good and perfect gift come from above...*(James 1:17)

#### 3. Adjust your course where needed.

*See if there be offense in me and lead me in the way everlasting*

#### 4. Act in obedience to God

*Prepare your mind for action* (1 Peter 1:13)
