

## Small Group Discussion Guide Genesis 3

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Pray that God would give you insight into today's study from Genesis.

- I. <u>Genesis 1-2.</u> Cover the beginning of God's Story. We see there that He is the author of everything. And we see that mankind is to be God's steward of all creation. Something goes wrong though.
  - a. Read Gen. 3:1-6
    - i. Who is the serpent? (Note Rev. 20:2)
    - ii. What strategy did Satan use to tempt Eve?
    - iii. Explain how the devil still tempts people today using this same strategy.
    - iv. What is our recourse as believers? (Note <u>1 Cor. 10:12-13</u>, <u>James 4:6-10</u>)
- II. Eve didn't really "fall into sin," she edged into it progressively.
  - a. Read again verse 6.
    - i. Explain how our responses to temptation move us progressively toward sin.
      - 1. Note <u>lames 1:13-15</u>
    - ii. What are the three points of temptation mentioned in 1 John 2:15-17?
- III. Now read Genesis 3:7-10
  - a. How did that first sin affect Adam and Eve's relationship with one another?
  - b. How did it affect their relationship with God?
  - c. How did it affect their relationship with creation?
  - d. How do our modern fears and shame reflect our sin today? Explain.
- IV. Finally, read Genesis 3:11-24
  - a. Note the different curses and their implications.
    - i. ...for the Serpent.
    - ii. ...for Eve
    - iii. ...for Adam
  - b. How does the cross of Christ ultimately redeem us from the curse of sin? (Be Specific)
