

Small Group Discussion Guide

(Week of March 6, 2022)

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to speak to you through the study of his word.

I. Let's take some time today to unpackage two more of Jesus' parables. Read [Luke 16:1-9](#). This is one of the harder parables to understand. What do you think Jesus' main point is? Is shrewdness a good or bad quality? In what sense should we use wealth to get ahead in this world?

II. Now read [Luke 16:10-15](#). Jesus continues on this theme of wealth and riches. Summarize his main point in verses 10-12. What are true riches? How might our use of money indicate the true condition of our hearts?

Now read [Luke 16:13-15](#). In what sense could this teaching have to do with the Pharisees? How could it relate to us today? In what ways can money become a substitute for God? Any examples?

III. Finally skip down and read [Luke 16:19-31](#). Jesus continues with his emphasis on money and wealth. What is the main point of the parable of the rich man and Lazarus? Can we make any observations about life after death from this parable? In what ways are "Moses and the Prophets" giving warnings to people today? What is their main message? Are people listening?

Close your group in prayer. Take a few minutes to check your own heart attitudes toward money and worldly wealth.
