Summarize verses 5-6. What exactly is faith? How does it grow? In what circumstances could we go around uprooting mulberry trees?

- III. Read <u>Luke 17:11-19</u>. What do you know about leprosy in Jesus' day? (Note <u>Numbers 5:1-3</u>) When exactly did this miracle occur? Why was Jesus surprised afterwards? One out of ten seems like a small percentage of people who were grateful. Where were the other 90%? Does 10% seem accurate today in our society? Share your ideas.
