Does Peter's willingness to go back out on the lake surprise you? What do you suppose Peter already knew about Jesus? What did the large catch of fish confirm to him? How did Peter's sin limit his relationship with Jesus in his own mind? How do you think Jesus saw Peter's sin? Explain your answer. What can we learn from Peter, James and John's willingness to follow Jesus, even though they were "sinners"?
- II. Now read <u>Luke 5:27-32</u>. Summarize what happened. How was Matthew's response to Jesus' call similar to Peter's? What can we learn about Jesus from his encounter with Matthew's friends? How did the Pharisees and religious leaders respond to Matthew and his friends? What lesson can we take away for our contacts with non-Christians today?
- III. Finally, finish your time by reading *Luke 9:23-26*. What is Jesus telling us here about discipleship? What is so difficult about discipleship? What might our cross be for us to carry daily in our day and age?
