

Small Group Discussion Guide

(Week of November 28, 2021)

As we break into December, consider as a group some kind of outreach or service you could be to someone or several in need this Christmas season. Ask God to direct your ideas in a way that you could be tangibly used to show God's love to others in the coming weeks.

I. Read [Luke 8:26-31](#). What impresses you about this story so far? Have you ever met someone who was demon possessed? What happened? What can we learn about demons from this text? What else do we know about them from other scriptures? (Note [Revelation 12:17, 13:7, Ephesians 4:26-27; 6:11-12, 2 Corinthians 11:3, 1 Peter 5:8-9](#))

II. Pick up the passage with [Luke 8:32-37](#). Twice Luke tells us that the townspeople were afraid. Why? Why weren't they thrilled like others who saw Jesus' miracles? Were these Jews? Would Jews keep pigs? What do you think?

III. Finally, read [Luke 8:38-39](#). Why do you suppose Jesus wouldn't let the man follow him? What was his assignment instead? Note Mark's version in [Mark 5:18-20](#).

*Can you share a way that God delivered you in some form from the power of the devil? What happened?

Finish your group in prayer. Pray Jesus' prayer for one another and for your family: "Deliver us from evil".

Finish your group in prayer. Pray Jesus' prayer for one another and for your family: "Deliver us from evil".
