The Condition of Satan

- 1. He can be bound in the name and through the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Mark 3:27, Luke 11:20, Rev.12:11)
- 2. He can be resisted (with prayer and scripture) and will flee. <u>(Luke 4:1-13, 1 Peter 5:8,9)</u>
- 3. He was defeated by Christ. (Hebrews 2:14, Colossians 2:15)
- 4. He has been "spoiled" by Christ. (Colossians 2:15)
- 5. He was crushed under the feet of the early Christians. (Romans 16:20)
- 6. He has been judged. (John 16:11)
- 7. He cannot touch the Spirit-filled believer without getting special permission from God. (1John 5:18, Job 1:10)
- 8. He has lost authority over Spirit-controlled Saints. (Acts 26:18, Colossians 1:13)
- 9. He cannot penetrate the "whole armor of God". (Ephesians 6:11-15)
- 10. He can be overcome. <u>(Revelations 12:11, 1 John 2:13, Ephesians 4:27)</u>
- 11. He (who is against me) is not greater than the One who is for me and in me. (1 John 4:4, Romans 8:31-39)
- 12. He is powerless to reclaim the soul of any believer. (John 10:29)
- 13. He cannot separate the believer from the love of God. (Romans 8:31-39)
- 14. He has but a "short time". (<u>Revelations 12:12</u>)
- 15. He believes in God and trembles. (James 2:19)
- 16. He must obey Christ. (Mark 1:27)
- 17. He is not omnipresent. (Matthew 4:11)

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Small Group Discussion Guide

"The Gospel of Mark"

Week of March 4, 2018

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Invite God to enlighten your hearts as you study his word.

This past week we looked at Jesus' response to demonics in the book of Mark. Let's broaden our study today and look at scripture relating to temptation, the spiritual battle and our victory in Christ.

- According to <u>Ezekiel 28:12-19</u> and <u>Isaiah 14:12-17</u>, who is Satan and where did he come from? Who are demons? What is their sphere of influence and how do they operate? Note the following: <u>2 Corinthians 2:10-11; 4:3-4; 6:14-17; 11:3</u>.
- II. God's word is his revelation of truth to the world. What does God's word do for us in each passage?

* <u>Psalm 119:9-11, 105</u>	* <i>Ephesians 5:25-27</i>
* <u>Matthew 4:4</u>	* <u>Hebrews 4:12</u>
*John 8:31-32; 17:17	*2 Peter 1:3-4

How does Satan contradict God's word according to <u>Genesis 3:1-4</u>, <u>John 8:44 and Revelation 12:10-11?</u>

III. Now read through the list on the other side of this outline (it's optional to look up the verses). Explain why knowing God's word (His truth) is necessary to combat the lies and temptations of the devil. <u>Ephesians 6:11</u> says we are to take our stand against the devil's schemes. If God's word is the sword of the Spirit (verse 17), give some practical examples of how to use specific scriptures to ward off the devil's attacks.

Close your group by praying <u>James 4:7</u>. Ask God to keep you alert and self-controlled (<u>1 Peter 5:8</u>) as you head out into the world each day.
