"The Gospel of Mark"

Week of March 11, 2018

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to strengthen your faith as you study his word.

- I. Today we will single out the topic of miracles from the gospel of Mark. How would you define "a miracle"? Why did Jesus do miracles in the gospels? In what cases did he <u>not</u> do miracles? Any examples? What conditions are necessary for God to do a miracle today?
- II. Read the following accounts of healings in Mark. Note what the sick person does and how Jesus responds in each story. Who initiates the healing? What role does faith play in the miracle? How might the example serve us today?
