Small Group Discussion Guide

"Every Member a Minister" Week of September 23, 2018

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to better clarify what His purpose is for your group in the coming weeks.

- I. As we enter into the fall season, the church is embarking on a two year plan to take us up to the year 2020. Last Sunday, Pastor Jim said we should aspire to be a church "of" groups, not just a church "with" groups. What's the difference? How can small groups be a discipleship tool? What do small groups offer that you normally can't get in a Sunday service?
- II. Read *Ephesians 4:11-16*. What is the role of spiritual leaders in verse 12? What kinds of "works of service" build up the body of Christ? According to verse 15, how does a believer grow in his or her faith? What part do other believers have in promoting growth? Note verse 16. Suggest ways that your small group could fulfill Paul's instructions for growing mature Christians.
- III. Now read <u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u>. According to verse 11, why does God give spiritual gifts? (Note <u>1 Corinthians 12:7</u>). How can you know what gift God has given you? In verse 12, Peter mentions two categories of gifts. What are they? Give some examples in each category. How can both speaking and serving gifts be developed and used in your small group meetings? Be specific.

The Empty Seat: As a group, place an empty chair in your circle each week. Use it as a reminder to pray for any of your members who are absent. You could also use it as a way for each member to pray for someone they want to lead to Christ this year. Pray in faith. God could fill the empty seat in response to your faith.



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
