*Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer.*

*This past month, we've launched a two year plan, aspiring to be a church where Every Member is a Minister. For this to occur, each member must commit to the Lordship of Christ, the Body of Christ and the Cause of Christ. Let's briefly summarize what each commitment involves.*

- I. Live the Life under the Lordship of Christ. Read [1 Peter 3:15](#). How can we practically set apart Jesus as Lord ([Colossians 2:6-7](#))? What will happen to our lives (our time commitments, relationships, priorities) when Jesus truly rules from within? ([Colossians 3:17,23](#))
- II. Be the Church under the Headship of Christ. Read [Ephesians 4:15-16](#). Explain how the church should function under the headship of Christ. As our leader, what do you think Christ wants us to become and do as a church? How well are we following him?
- III. Extend the Kingdom of God. Read [Luke 13:18-21](#). What main point is Jesus illustrating with each parable? Explain how this truth has played out in your own life experience. In what ways can we help people outside the church experience God's kingdom? Be specific.
- IV. The upcoming Kingdom Assignment involves our small group ministry. Each small group will be given money to help fund an outreach project. Have you discussed this idea as a group? What kinds of things could you see your group doing? How will you decide as a group what your final project will be? How should prayer be part of your group's Kingdom Assignment?
