Small Group Discussion Guide

Week of February 17, 2019

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to work in your group and in our congregation in a way that <u>every member</u> could become a <u>minister</u>.

- I. Pick up in our study of Romans by reading <u>Romans 10:1-4</u>. Paul is asking and answering the question "What about the nation of Israel?" According to this section, is salvation based on zeal for God or on truth about God? What if someone is sincere, will their sincerity save them? What is the righteous way that God has supplied for Israel, and for us?
- II. Read <u>Romans 10:5-13</u>. Paul reiterates the gospel in this section. Explain the difference between living "by the law", and faith in Christ. What is the relationship between believing and confessing? Does verse 13 apply to everyone? Explain your answer.
- III. Now read <u>Romans 10:14-17</u>. Review the progression Paul outlines here, beginning with preaching. What is our role now as believers? Share an example from your own life where either God used you to share (preach) the gospel, or where you heard the message through someone else. According to verse 17, why is it necessary to talk abut Jesus Christ? What if Christians remain silent? Suggest some ways we as a church can better "send" our members out to share the gospel.
- IV. Finish your time by reading <u>Romans 10:18-21</u>. Israel did not respond to the gospel as a nation. Some Jews did come to Christ though. Likewise, not everyone we talk to will be interested in God. But, some will!
- V. Pray for your group, and for our church. Ask God to fulfill his word in us as found in *Isaiah 52:7*. May he use us to reach those who have yet to hear and believe!
