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Small Group Discussion Guide

Week of March 10, 2019 (Romans 13)

Open your group by discussing the <u>Small Group Outreach Project</u>. <i>Ask God to give you insight and direction as you share ideas.

- I. We are looking at the last section of Romans (chapters 12-16), dealing with Christian relationships and service. Read <u>Romans 13:1-7</u>. What "catches your eye" in this passage? Define authority. How is it similar and different from power? What lines of authority has God established for the social order? According to verse 4 and 6, what is God's purpose for national governments? (<u>Note Acts 4:17-20</u>) How are Christians instructed to respond to governmental authorities? What if the government is pagan, or even evil?
- II. Now read <u>Romans 13:8-10</u>. In what ways do we each have a debt to love others? Any personal examples? Why did God give Israel the Old Testament laws and how does love practically fulfill those laws? (Note <u>Matthew 22:36-40</u>). What is the role of the Holy Spirit in helping us to "fulfill the law"? (Note <u>2 Corinthians 3:6,18</u>)
- III. Finally, read <u>Romans 13:11-14</u>. What "present time" are we living in? Are Christians asleep? Explain. How can a person consciously put aside deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light? How do we clothe ourselves with Jesus Christ? What would happen to a Christian who spent time thinking about how to gratify the sinful nature? How should we deal with our sinful nature?
