Take time to check in as a group. How is Bold Faith going?. Any "wristband encounters" or "bold faith experiences"? What have you read in your devotions this past week that has encouraged you? Pray for your group and ask God to continue to develop bold faith in your lives.

- Return in your Bible to <u>Judges 6</u>. Last week, we saw the situation in Israel where they had turned from God to idols. The <u>Midianites</u> invaded and God called Gideon to change the situation. Remember Gideon's personal condition when the angel appeared to him? Read <u>(1 Cor. 1:26-31)</u>. How can you relate to both Gideon and the Corinthians?
- II. Now read *Judges 6:16-24*. Why did Gideon offer food? Who might he have thought the angel was? Notice a similar account in *Judges 13:15-23*.
- III. God's first assignment is to take his newfound bold faith home. Read *Judges 6:25-32.* Gideon obeyed, but he did so at night. Why? What resulted in his home town at first? What about later on (*vs. 34*)? What challenges have you faced in living out your faith at home? Be specific.
- IV. Finally, read <u>Judges 6:33-40</u>. Gideon second guesses himself and his assignment. Is it okay to ask God to give us signs in order to be sure of his will? When might putting out a fleece actually be an act of disobedience or disbelief? How did Jesus deal with this in <u>Matthew 16:1-4</u>?
