Small Group Discussion Guide (Week of January 12, 2020)

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. How were your holidays? You might want to take a few minutes and share any highlights from this past Christmas season.

In our sudy of Ephesians this past fall, we have highlighted Ephesians 2:10. Read the verse out loud. Someone summarize its significance for us as 21st century Christians (what is our identify? What is our purpose? How is God working ahead of us?)

*Your group assignment for the winter quarter is to identify a "good work" that you could do together on behalf of God's kingdom in Branch County. We are calling this our "2020 Kingdom Projects".

As a group, work through the following planning scheme. Talk about the importance of each step. Take note of thoughts, ideas and possible courses of action for your group in the coming weeks. Each group facilitator should keep a "master copy" of your discussion to use as a guide for your specific Kingdom Project in the coming weeks. God is working in and through your small group. Ask him to direct you as you develop this corporate outreach project.

Kingdom Project Worksheet

Step One: PRAY (James 1:5, 1 Peter 1:13, John 16:24)

Ask God for wisdom and guidance as you begin to plan together.

Step Two: SURVEY

As a group, brainstorm possible needs and opportunities you could reach out to in the community. You may want to refer back to the small group outline on December 8. What ministries are already working to address these needs that your small group couild possibly assist or support? What areas of need are not being addressed?

Step Three: EVALUATE

As a group, discuss each of the suggestions and ideas. Narrow your focus to the top 2 or 3 possibilities. How can you learn more about each option in the next couple weeks?

Step Four: DECIDE (*Romans 12:1-2*)

Make an initial decision and, as a group, move in that direction. Watch to see if God confirms your steps, or perhaps, if he redirects your course towards something else.

Step Five: PLAN (*Proverbs 16:3,9*)

Write up a one page proposal outlining your group's Kingdom Project. What are you wanting to do? How and when will this happen? Is there a budget for your idea that you wish to submit to the church council for funding? Share your idea with other Christians for feedback, encouragement and affirmation.

Step Six: DO IT!

Execute your plan and watch to see how God works in and through your group.

Be open to new things and next steps he may have for you to do. Remember, he has made us for good works, which he has prepared in advance for rus to do (*Ephesians 2:10*)

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
