

Small Group Discussion Guide <u>*Titus 2: 11-14</u>*</u>

Open your group with a time of sharing and prayer. Ask God to open your eyes to "good works" that he desires to do through you in the coming days.

- I. The past few weeks we've looked at the topic of good works from the book of Titus. As a group, survey <u>Titus 1-3.</u>
 - a. Identify every verse that mentions, "What is good."
 - b. How do we know the good that God wants us to do?
 - c. How do good works generally relate to other people and their needs?
 - i. Give examples.
- II. Now read our main verses: <u>Titus 2:11-14</u>
 - a. Whose good works bring about our salvation?
 - b. Our sanctification?
 - c. In what sense is service really God serving others through us?
 - d. Note Gal. 2:20, <u>1 Peter 4:10-11</u>
- III. Read <u>verse 13</u> again. Explain the appearing of the glory of God. When will this happen?
 - a. What follows His arrival?
 - b. Now read <u>Titus 1:2; 3:7.</u>
 - i. What do these verses say our hope should be?
 - ii. What exactly is hope?
 - iii. How should our hope of heaven temper our living on earth hear and now?
 - iv. How can our future glorification affect the way we deal with present sufferings? Trials? Discouragement and difficulties? Any examples?

Close your group by asking God to give you a greater sense of hope (confident expectation) for the future glory we will share when Christ finally returns. Ask him to use us to share that hope with others who need it.
